WORSHIP NOTES

Message: "See My Hands" Scripture: John 20:24-31

Summary: This is the story of Jesus appearing to Thomas. We often associate Thomas with doubt, however, Thomas' main obstacle was control. Yet the appearance of Jesus shatters our lack of imagination. His love shatters our control. "Touch my hands." The three words of invitation to a resurrected life.
